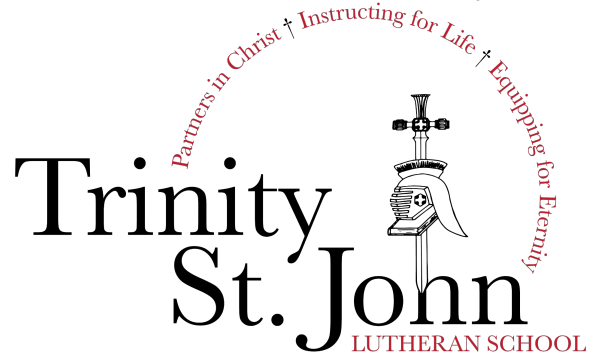

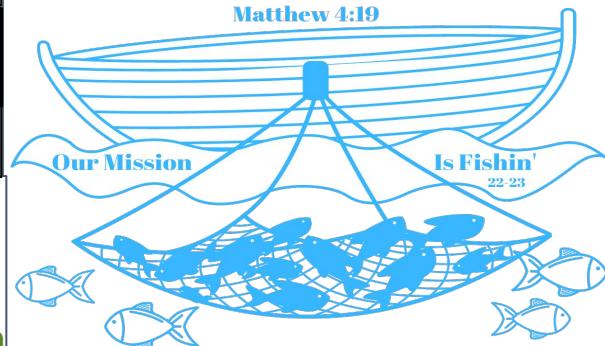


Note from the Principal
