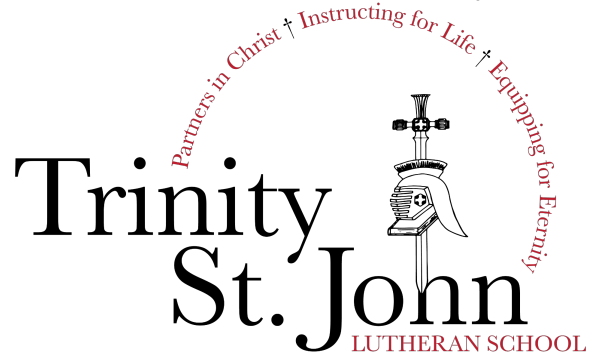

- T-SJ, it is great to serve amongst my T-SJ family.

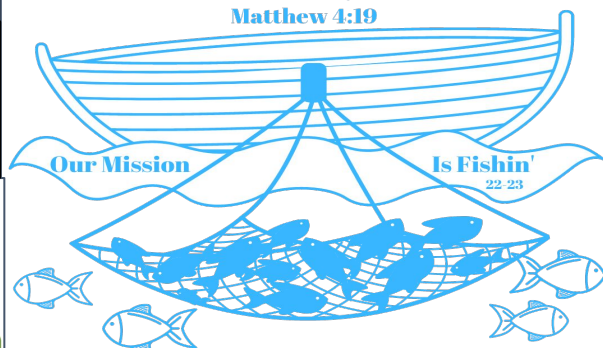
I pray that God reminds us every day of the many blessings that He has surrounded us with!
