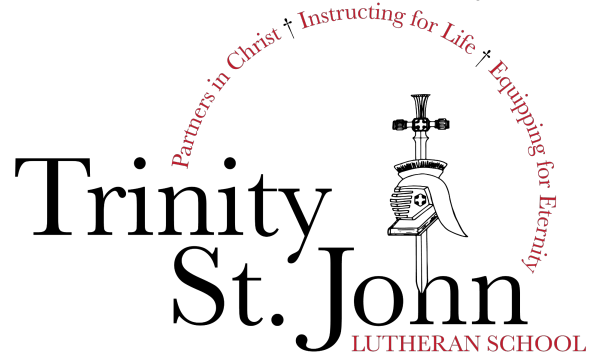

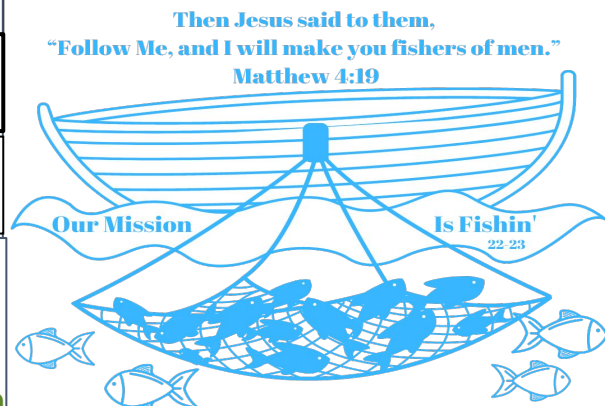


## Note from the Principal
