If a teacher runs out of spaces available or you cannot make it during the specific times, please contact your child's teacher to arrange another time to meet.

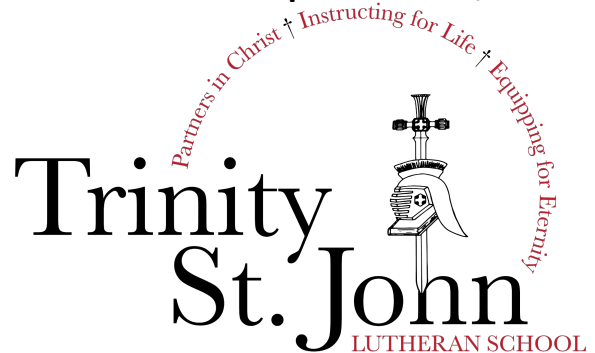

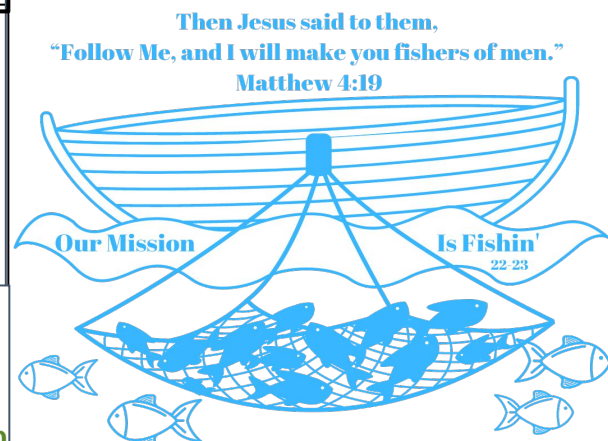
Note from the Principal
